SCENE ONE

TWO KIDS ARE TALKING ON ZOOM OR  
FACETIME. BRET IS WEARING A HAT.

TERI

Hi Bret! How are you!

BRET

Hi, Teri! Oh, I have missed you!

TERI

I have missed you, too!

BRET

What have you been doing?

TERI

Not much. Fighting with my little(brother/sister)mostly.

BRET

Hey, at least you HAVE one. It's only me around here.

TERI

What about your Mom and Dad?

BRET

You mean those people who work on the computer all day? They  
are NOT as much fun as my friends.

TERI

I like your hat.

BRET

Thanks. Teri, have you seen my bracelet with the little blue  
heart on it?

TERI

No. Why?

BRET

I think I left it at your house about a million years ago.

TERI

Nope. I haven't seen it.

BRET

Are you sure?

TERI

I haven't seen it. Oooh, I'm going to get my hat.  
(TERI turns around to grab a hat behind her that is on a table or dresser. SHE puts it on.)

BRET

Oooh, that's cute! Wait. I see something.

TERI

What do you mean?

BRET

Something shiny. I see something that was under your hat. It looks like my bracelet!

TERI

Where?

BRET

Right there! Look! What is that?

TERI

Oh, my gosh! (SHE lifts up the bracelet.) Is this the one?

BRET

Yes! I thought you said you didn't have it!

TERI

I have no idea how it got there.

BRET

REALLY? I thought you were my friend! Did you take my bracelet?

TERI

No! How could you think that?

BRET

I asked you. You said you didn't have it. There it was, right under your hat!

TERI

Bret, I did NOT take it! I did not even know it was there!

BRET

Some friend YOU are! I have to go, my Mom needs me.

TERI

Bret! Bret! (BRET disappears from the screen.) Well, goodbye to you, too. (TERI disappears from the screen)

SCENE TWO

BRET

Hello. Why are you calling me?

TERI

I am calling you because there is someone who wants to talk to you. Come here, Sammy.

(TERI pulls SAMMY to the screen, SAMMY has the bracelet.)

SAMMY

Mine!

TERI

No, Sammy, it is not yours it belongs to Bret.

SAMMY

Hi Bret! Hi! Hi! Hi! Mine!

BRET

Hi Sammy! Sammy, what do you have?

SAMMY

Mine! Pretty!

TERI

Where did you get that, Sammy?

SAMMY

I found it! Mine!

BRET

Sammy took it?

TERI

My Mom told me that she found it on the ground in the yard. She gave it to Sammy to look at. Then she forgot about it.

BRET

Sammy, that's mine!

SAMMY

Here, Bret! Here it is! Take it!

(SAMMY tries to give it to TERI through the screen)

BRET

No, I can't take it through the video screen! You silly!

(BRET and TERI start laughing.)

TERI

Sammy, we can save it for her, okay?

SAMMY

Okay.

(SAMMY gives it to TERI and leaves the screen.)

BRET

I'm sorry.

TERI

If you don't believe me, I can get my Mom to tell you.

BRET

No. I believe you. I'm sorry.

TERI

Bret, I have to say something. It really hurt my feelings when you thought I took your bracelet.



BRET

I'm sorry.

TERI

I would NEVER do that to you. I would not take something that didn't belong to me. Especially, someone who is my very best friend!

BRET

I am?

TERI

Yes, of course!

BRET

Can you forgive me? I just...

TERI

I am going to put it right here. I am going to save it for you until we see each other again.

BRET

Thank you. Are we still friends?

TERI

Mmmm, let me think for a minute. (SHE pauses. BRET looks worried.) YES, we are still friends! Are you kidding me?

BRET

We always have good laughs, don't we?

TERI

Yes. We do! Just forget about it!

BRET

I'll call you tomorrow and we can play!
